Snow forecast - Thursday 15 November 2012

High pressure has dominated the Alps this week and although some valleys have been plagued by low cloud, it has been wall to wall sunshine at altitude.

There will be very little change in the weather in the Alps over the next few days so we will not be going into a country by country forecast this week. Some low cloud will persist in the valley bottoms, otherwise it's more of the same with virtually unbroken sunshine at altitude and freezing levels at or above 3000m. Over the weekend, a subtle shift in wind direction (to the south) might bring a few more clouds here and there but generally speaking it should stay dry and bright.

Looking further ahead, there may be one or two showers on Monday but most places will again stay dry next week with lots of sunshine, especially at altitude. There is no chance of any significant snow in the Alps before the weekend of 24/25 November at the earliest.


