Spring continues until Friday...

Austria

European Resorts A-Z

Today (Tuesday) will be rather cloudy at times with the best of any sunshine in the southern Austrian Alps. Most places will be dry, but the odd light rain shower is possible in the north and west. It will be mild with freezing levels close to 3000m.

Wednesday will be mostly dry, warm and sunny once any early showers clear the far north-eastern Austrian Alps. It will continue sunny on Thursday and will become warmer still with temperatures reaching 22-25°C in many of the lower valleys, and freezing levels close to 3500m. Colder and more showery $\,$ weather will move in from the north-west on Friday with snow possible to 1500-2000m later in the day.

France

Today (Tuesday) will be mostly dry, with plenty of sunshine once any early cloud breaks up. It will feel warm, with freezing levels close to 3000m. It will continue warm and mostly sunny on **Wednesday** with freezing levels creeping up towards 3500m.

Thursday will begin fine, but cloud amounts may increase in the northern Alps later in the day. It will remain warm. Friday will see a big change as a cold front introduces colder more showery weather from the north-west (snow possible to 1500m).

Italy

Today (**Tuesday**) will be dry and mostly sunny in all regions, with freezing levels close to 3000m. **Wednesday** and **Thursday** will continue fine and spring-like with a slight increase in temperatures (freezing levels 3300m).

Friday will see much colder air move in from the north with the risk of showers. A little snow is possible above 1500-2000m.

Switzerland

Today (**Tuesday**) will start cloudy in places, but the sun should burn through and most regions can expect a fine, warm day with freezing levels close to 3000m. It will continue fine and warm on **Wednesday** with a slight increase in afternoon temperatures.

Thursday will begin sunny, but cloud may increase in the far north-west later in the day. It will remain warm with freezing levels above 3000m. **Friday** will see much colder showery weather move in from the north-west with some snow possible to 1500m.
