Snow forecast - Monday 22 April 2013

After the big storm of Friday & Saturday, the weather is trying to settle down and it should feel something like summer again by the middle of the week.

Detailed forecast:

Austria

Monday will see a mixture of cloud and some brighter spells. Many places will stay dry, but the odd light shower (snow 1700m or so) can't be ruled out. **Tuesday** will be a mostly fine day with increasing amounts of sunshine across all regions. It will be a little warmer too with freezing levels around 2600m.

Wednesday and Thursday will be warmer still, with lots of sunshine and freezing levels back above 3000m.



Like many other resorts in the Alps it's only sunny at altitude first thing this morning. This is Sölden.

France

There is still a lot of cloud around today (Monday) particularly at low altitude. Higher up, however, it is sunnier and it should brighten up in many other places too as the day goes on. It is still on the cool side for the time of year with freezing levels only just creeping above 2000m. Tuesday will see $\stackrel{,}{\text{more}}$ in the way of sunshine for all regions. It will also start to warm up, with freezing levels close to 2500m.

The fine weather will continue into Wednesday and Thursday with freezing levels once again reaching or surpassing 3000m.

Italy

Monday will continue to see plenty of cloud and the odd shower (snow 2000m). However, some bright or sunny spells are also likely in places. It should be generally brighter and a little warmer on **Tuesday**.

By ${\it Wednesday}$ and ${\it Thursday}$ everywhere will be warm and sunny with freezing levels back to or above 3000m.

Switzerland

Monday will see plenty of cloud lingering in the lower valleys of the northern Alps. However, higher up the sun is shining and most other places should brighten up as the day goes on. But it remains cool, with freezing levels barely exceeding 2000m. **Tuesday** will see more in the way of sunshine across the Swiss Alps and a slight rise in temperature.

 $\mbox{Wednesday}$ and $\mbox{Thursday}$ will be warm and sunny with freezing levels back to or above 3000m.
