### **Snow forecast**

Updated: 11.45am Friday 21 November 2014

The weather has now settled down and will remain uneventful across the Alps for the next few days. This means that it will essentially stay dry until the middle of next week (at least) with a mixture of sunny spells and cloudier interludes. It will be mild too, especially at altitude, with freezing levels surpassing 3000m.

The next serious snowfall is likely to be towards the tail end of next week , once again favouring Italy and the southern Alps. Other regions may also get some action in due course, but putting any details on proceedings at this stage is impossible. Stay tuned to our daily updates...

### **Detailed forecast:**

#### Austria

**Saturday**, **Sunday** and **Monday** will be dry with sunny spells but also some cloudier interludes at times. Fog may also plague some lower valley bottoms. It will be mild, especially at altitude, with maximum temperatures reaching +11°C in **Lech** (1450m) by **Monday**!

### France

**Saturday**, **Sunday** and **Monday** will be mostly dry with sunny spells but also plenty of cloud drifting around, especially close to the Italian border early next week. It will also be mild with a maximum temperature of +7°C in **Val Thorens** (2300m) by **Monday**, and freezing levels above 3000m.

## Italy


**Saturday**, **Sunday** and **Monday** will be mostly dry with sunny spells and cloudier interludes. It will feel mild, especially at altitude, with freezing levels climbing above 3000m and maximum temperatures in **Cervinia** (2050m) somewhere around +8°C by **Monday**.

## **Switzerland**

Saturday, Sunday and Monday will be dry with sunny spells, but also some cloud at times. It will be mild with freezing levels reaching or surpassing 3000m and maximum temperatures as high as +10°C in **Zermatt** (1620m) by **Monday**.

## Outlook:

It will slowly turn more unsettled from the south and west from mid-week onwards, but it may be the end of the week before we see any widespread significant snow. Right now it looks like Italy and the southern Alpine resorts will be most favoured, but other parts of the Alps should also see some snow in due course.
