Snow forecast

Updated: 8.45pm Tuesday 7 April 2015

After an unusually cool early April, the Alpine weather is warming up again with freezing levels expected to reach 3000m towards the end of the week.

The last of the flurries affecting the extreme eastern Austrian Alps will also move away, to allow all areas to enjoy a mostly sunny and increasingly warm spell of weather. Indeed temperatures in some of the lower Alpine valleys could reach 20°C on Thursday and Friday, before it turns a little cooler again over the weekend.

Detailed snow forecast:

Austria

Wednesday will see a little cloud over the far eastern Austrian Alps at first. Otherwise it will be dry with plenty of sunshine and warmer temperatures than of late, with freezing levels at 2100m in the west by the afternoon.

It will remain fine on $\bf Thursday$ and $\bf Friday$, with freezing levels pushing 3000m.

France

Wednesday will be mostly sunny but warmer than of late, with freezing levels around 2400m.

Thursday and **Friday** will be warmer still with freezing levels around 3000m. It will remain mostly sunny with just a few afternoon cumulus clouds forming over the peaks.

Italy

 $\begin{tabular}{ll} \textbf{Wednesday} & will be mostly sunny and warmer than of late with freezing levels around 2100m in the east (Dolomites), but around 2700m in the west. \end{tabular}$

It will remain mostly fine on $\bf Thursday$ and $\bf Friday$ with freezing levels close to 3000m.

Switzerland

Wednesday will be mostly sunny with freezing levels between 2200m and 2500m.

It will continue fine on **Thursday** and **Friday** with just a little patchy afternoon cloud, especially in the west, and freezing levels close to 3000m.
