Snow forecast

Updated: 3.30pm Friday 10 April 2015

After the fine and increasingly warm weather the Alps have experienced over the last few days, it will turn slightly cooler (and in places cloudier) on Saturday with the odd shower here and there. However, no major precipitation is expected and many places will stay dry and bright.

It also looks fairly settled next week, with long spells of sunshine and warm afternoon temperatures. All in all, spring remains in control.

Detailed snow forecast:

Austria

Saturday will see variable cloud with sunny spells but also a scattering of showers, especially in the northern and western Austrian Alps, with a dusting of snow here and there above 1800-2000m.

Sunday and **Monday** will be mostly dry with sunny spells and just the odd isolated shower in the northern and eastern Alps. Freezing levels will be around 2500m.




Blue skies today across Austria. This is Astental - Photo: foto-webcam.eu

France

Saturday will see variable cloud with sunny spells, especially in the south, but with the odd afternoon shower (snow 2000m), though no significant precipitation is expected.


Sunday and **Monday** will be mostly dry with good sunny spells and just a very low risk of an afternoon shower. Freezing levels will settle around 2500m.

Italy

Saturday will be mostly dry with variable cloud, sunny spells and just the outside chance of a shower in the north-western Italian Alps (snow 2000m).

Sunday and Monday will be mostly fine and a shade warmer with freezing levels settling around 2700m.

Switzerland

 $\textbf{Saturday} \ \text{will see variable cloud.} \ \text{Most places will stay dry, but a few well}$ scattered afternoon showers are possible (snow 2000m) here and there. The best of any sunshine will be in the far south.

Sunday and Monday will be mostly fine with sunny spells, and just a very low risk of an afternoon shower. Freezing levels will settle around 2500m.
