Latest snow forecast

Updated: 5.30pm Thursday 23 April 2015

After several days of fine spring weather, it's all change in the Alps this weekend – though it will be Sunday night before we see a significant drop in temperature.

Today (Thursday) was mostly fine, but some showers (snow above 1600-1800m) did affect the southern and eastern Austrian Alps as well as parts of the Dolomites. Friday will be mostly fine again before the weather becomes more generally unsettled from the west over the weekend.

By Monday it will have turned much colder, with snow to 1000m in parts of the northern Alps and some significant accumulations possible (almost anywhere) at altitude.

Detailed snow forecast:

Austria

Friday will see early showers clear the far eastern and southern Alps, then all areas will be dry with sunny spells and freezing levels around 2500m.

Saturday will start dry and bright but cloud will build in the western Austrian Alps with a few showers (snow 2500m) later in the day. The eastern Alps should stay dry.

Showers will become a little more widespread on **Sunday** but will remain scattered, with a little snow above 2500m.

On **Monday** it will turn much colder with widespread snow showers to as low as 1400m.

France

Friday will be dry with long sunny spells and just a little cloud bubbling up later in the day. It will feel pleasant in the afternoon with freezing levels around 2700m.

Saturday will see more in the way of cloud with showers breaking out, especially later in the day (snow 2300m).

These showers will become heavier and more prolonged on **Sunday** with snow to 2000m later in the day.

Monday will be cold and windy with snow showers to as low as 1000m.

Italy

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Friday will be mostly dry with sunny spells and freezing levels around 2700m.

Saturday will be cloudier with occasional showers, most frequent in the north-western Italian Alps with a little snow above 2200m.

Sunday will see further showers, again most frequent in the western Alps, with a little snow above 2000-2200m.

It will turn colder but continue to be showery on **Monday**, with the rain/snow limit falling to 1200-1500m in the west, 1400-1600m in the east.

Switzerland

Friday will be dry with long sunny spells and just a little cloud later in the day. Freezing levels will be around 2600m.

Saturday will be cloudier with showers in the west, moving further east later in the day. The rain/snow limit will be around 2300m.

Sunday will see further showers or longer periods of rain, heaviest later in the day with snow to 2000-2200m.

Monday will be much colder with plenty of showers and snow to 1000-1400m.

Outlook:

It will be cool with occasional wintry showers on Tuesday (especially in the north). Thereafter the weather may settle down for a while, but there is lots of uncertainty at present.
