Snow forecast

Updated: 6.30pm Monday 11 November 2013

After the weekend's big dumps, it's a quieter start to the week but there is more snow in the forecast, albeit in much smaller quantities.

Detailed snow forecast:

Austria

Tuesday will be dry with plenty of sunshine, particularly at altitude.

Wednesday will again be dry with sunny spells in the western Austrian Alps, but a little cloudier with the chance of light flurries (1000m) in the far eastern Alps.

Thursday will be mostly dry with broken cloud and sunny spells.

On **Friday** a weather system will drop down from the north bringing colder air and (mostly light) snow showers to low levels across many regions.

France

Tuesday will be dry with plenty of sunshine, at least at altitude though it may cloud over in the far northern Alps later.

Wednesday may start cloudy in the far northern Alps, but the sun should soon break through with most areas enjoying a fine day.

Thursday should also be mostly fine though cloud will increase again in the far northern Alps later with the chance of a few light flurries (1000m) overnight.

Friday will be cold and generally cloudy with a few flurries possible to low levels.

Italy


The Italian Alps will stay dry and mostly sunny on $\bf Tuesday, \, Wednesday \, and \, \bf Thursday.$

 $\mbox{\bf Friday}$ is likely to be colder and cloudier with snow flurries to low levels at times.

Switzerland

Tuesday will be dry with plenty of sunshine, especially at altitude, but cloud may thicken up in the far north-west later.

On **Wednesday** it may start cloudy across the northern Alps but it should soon brighten up with all areas enjoying plenty of afternoon sunshine.
